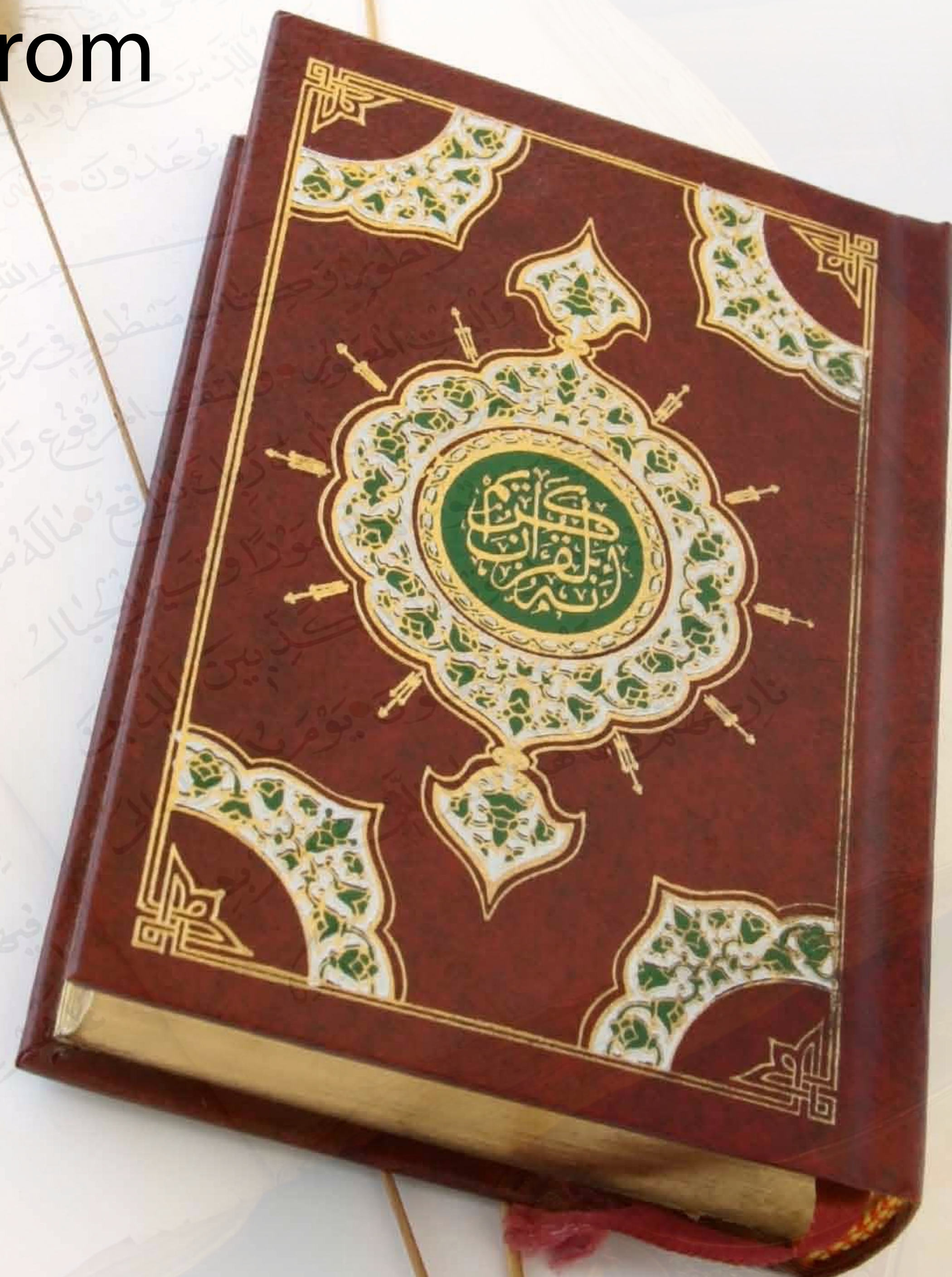
**W**ill they not ponder on the Qur'an? If it had been from other than God they would have found therein much incongruity (inconsistency).

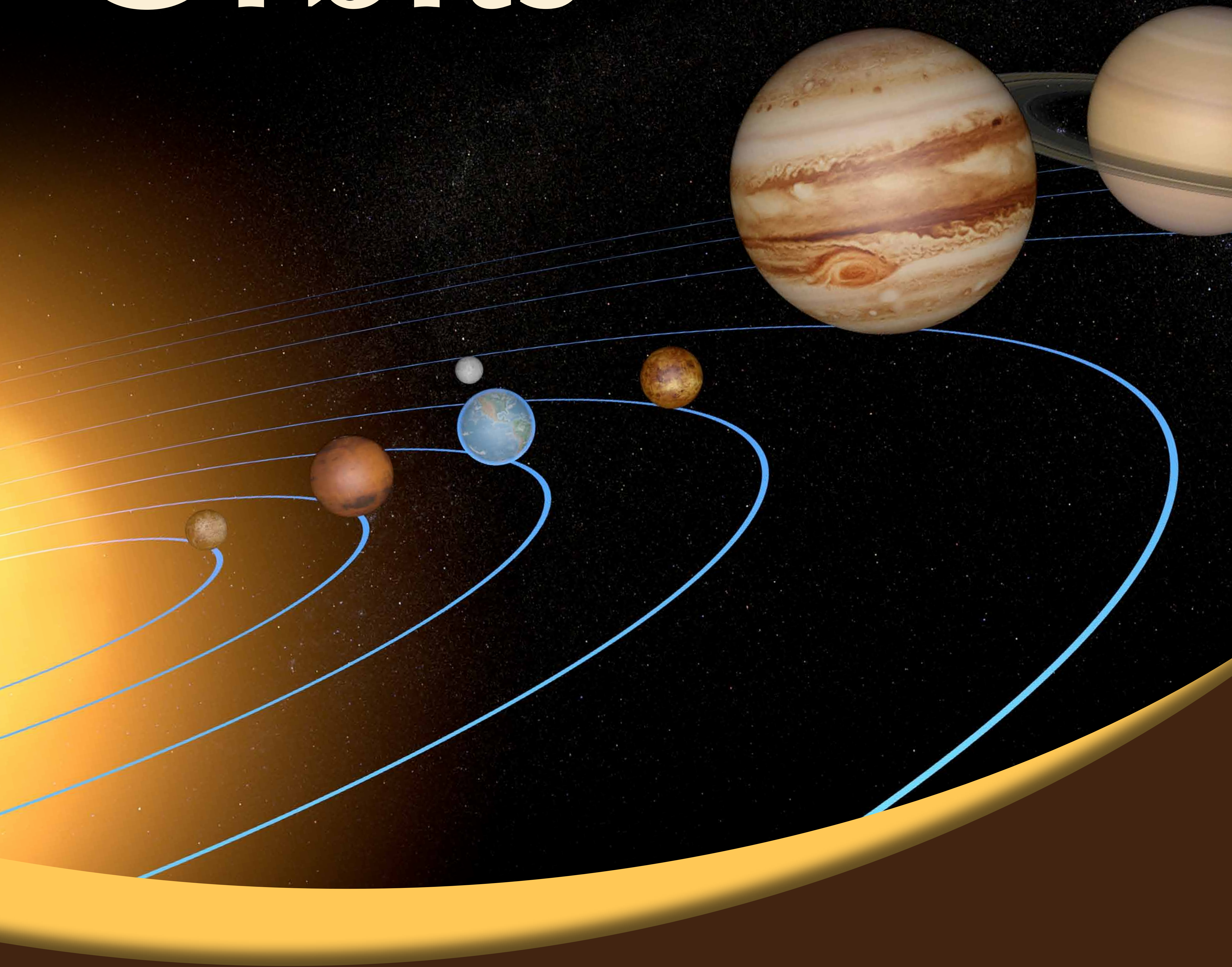
## The Cosmic Web of Forces and Magnetic Fields

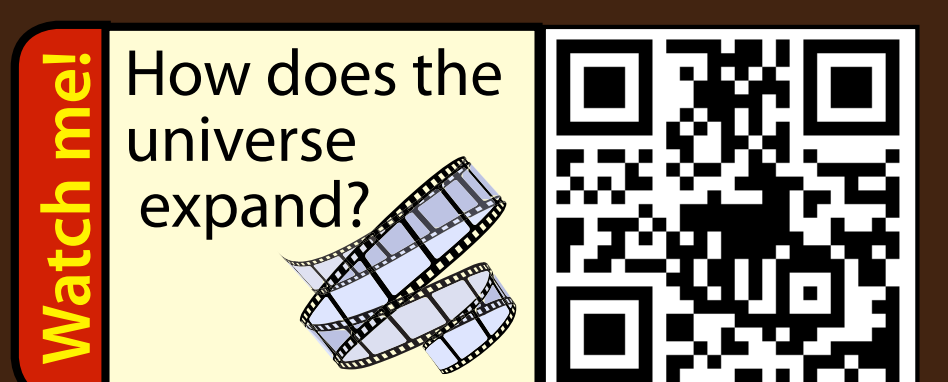

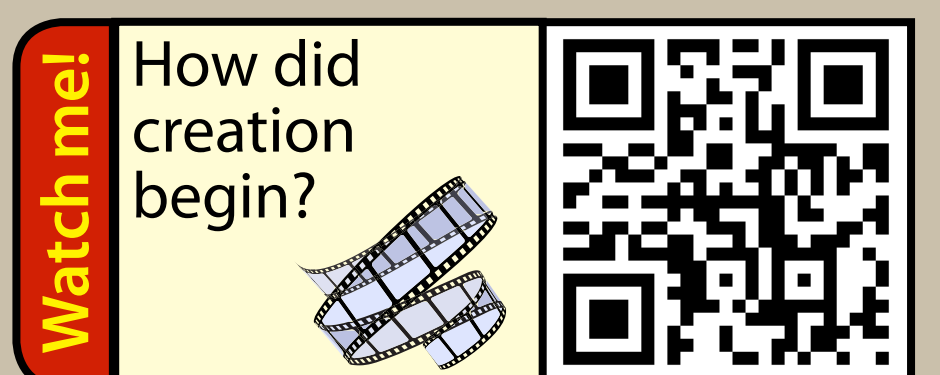
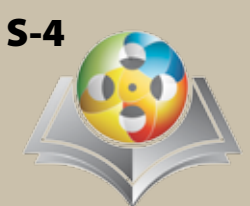


# Big Bang

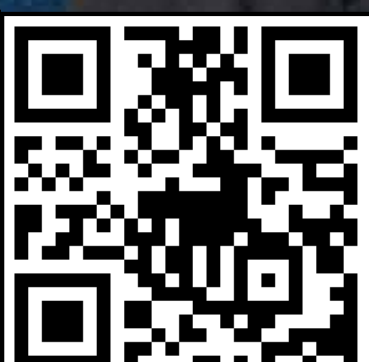
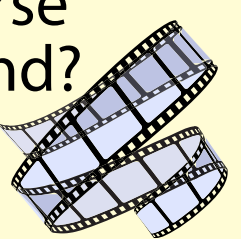

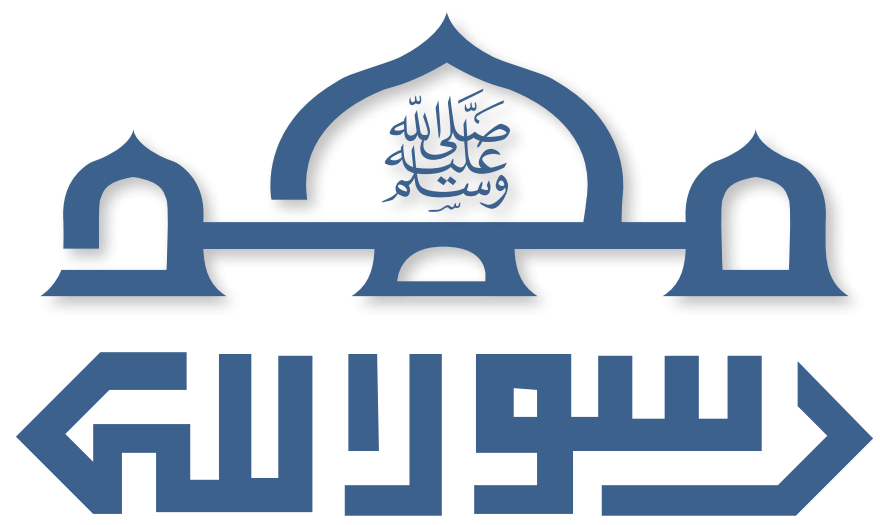

# MUHAMMAD ﷺ Farewell Sermon



In the year 632 CE, Prophet Muhammad ﷺ performed pilgrimage in Makkah and gave his final sermon to more than 100,000 people in an area called Arafat. He stood at the bottom of a mount called “Mount of Mercy” and addressed all pilgrims. His sermon reminded people of the basic elements of faith, belief in one God, the sanctity of life and property, the equality of all races, rules of justice, women’s rights and obligations, and moral precepts. Here are brief excerpts from the final sermon:

**O People !**

Listen attentively to me for I do not know if I will meet you again after this year and in this place.

**O People !**

Verily, your blood, your property and your honor are sacred and inviolable until you appear before your Lord, as the sacred inviolability of this day and this month of yours. Verily, you will soon meet your Lord and you will be held answerable for your actions.

**O People !**

Your Lord is one and your father is one. All humankind is from Adam and Adam is fashioned from clay, no superiority except by piety.



At the end of his sermon, Prophet Muhammad ﷺ said to all present people: What will you say when you are asked about me? They said: We bear witness that you carefully conveyed the Message. Prophet Muhammad ﷺ said while pointing with his index finger to the sky then to them:

**O my Lord be my witness.**

(He did that three times)







..So, is there any duty upon the messengers except the conveyance of a clear message?

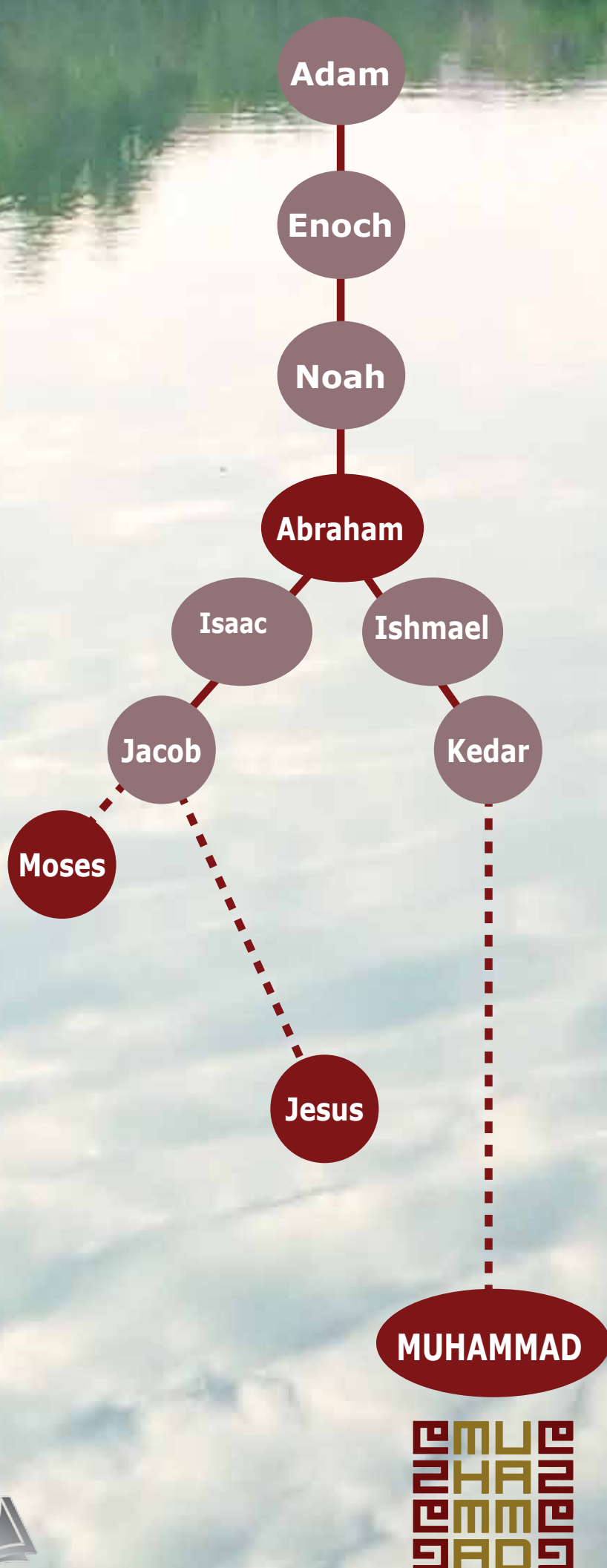

# YOUR MOTHER FIRST

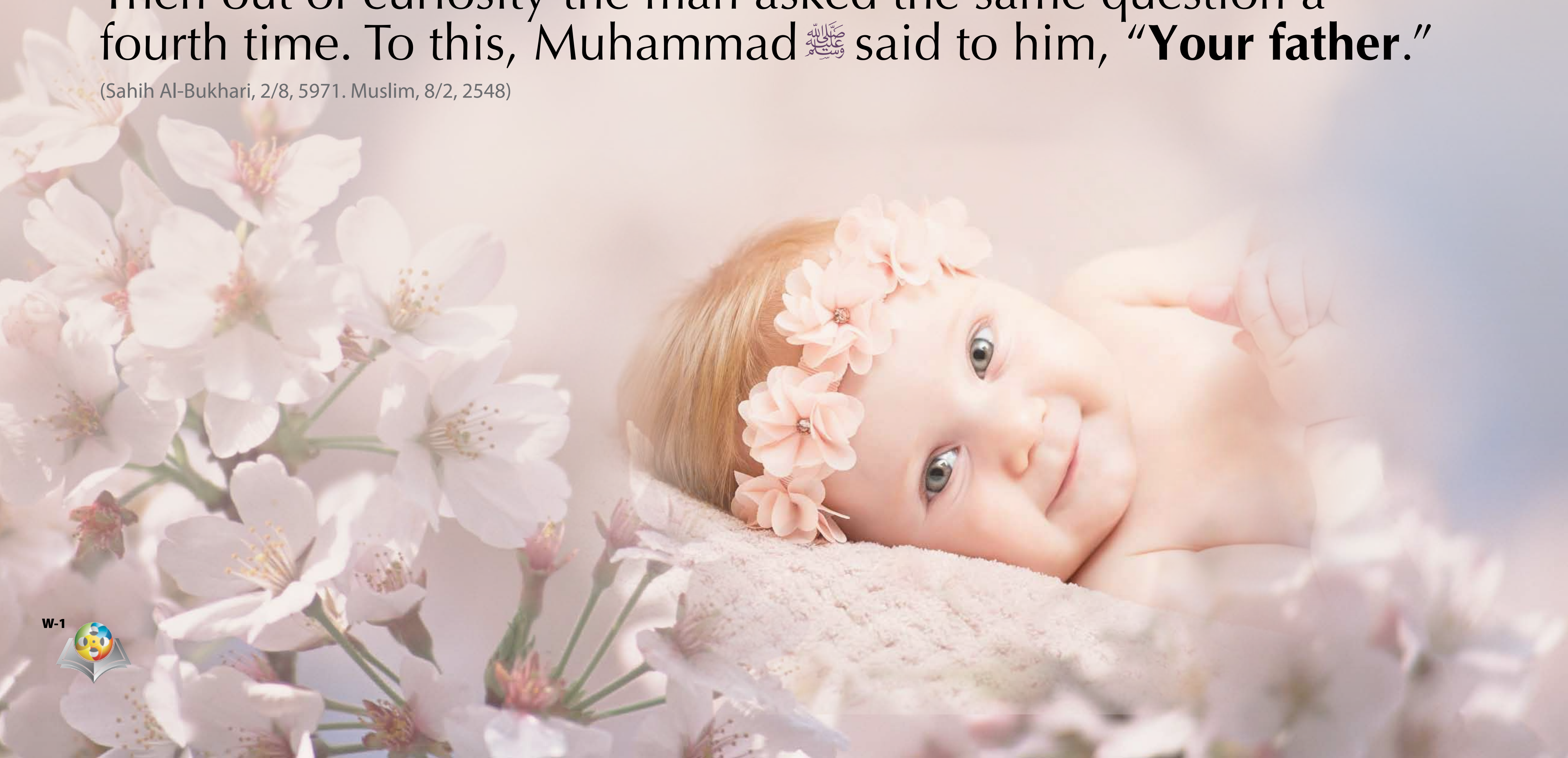
A man asked Muhammad ﷺ : “Who deserves my closest support and companionship?”

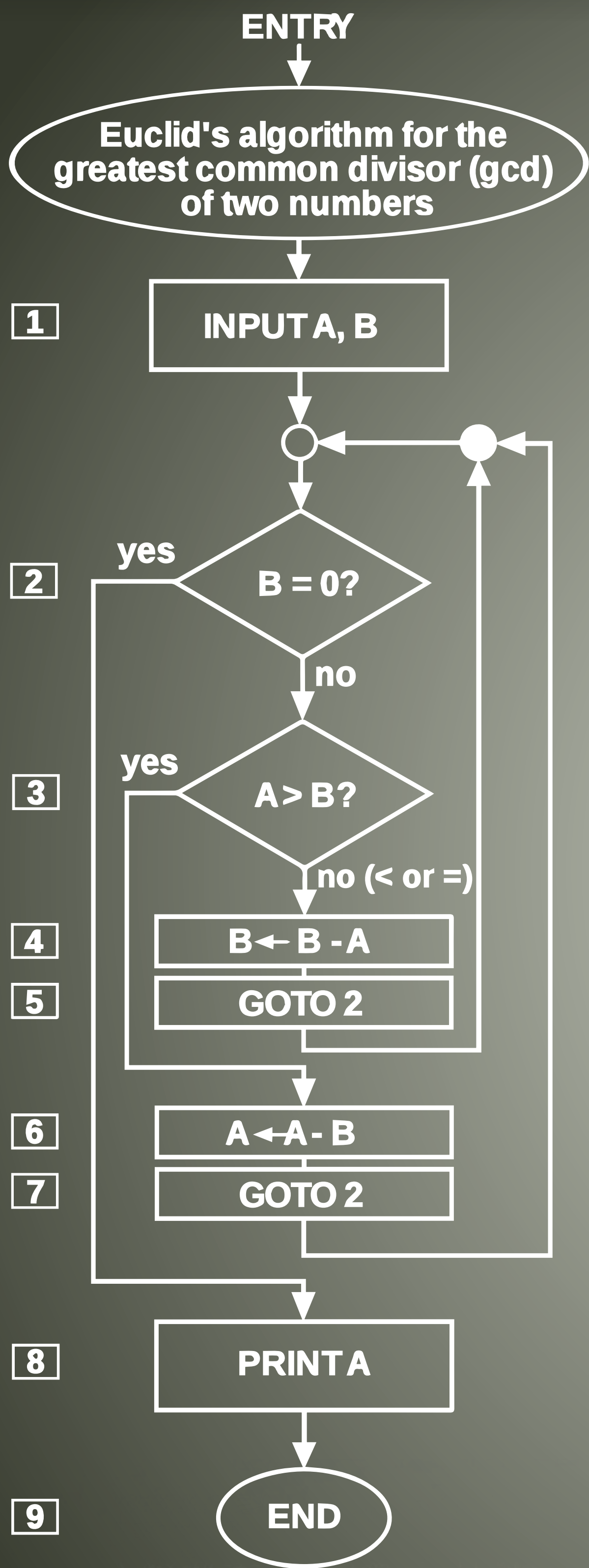




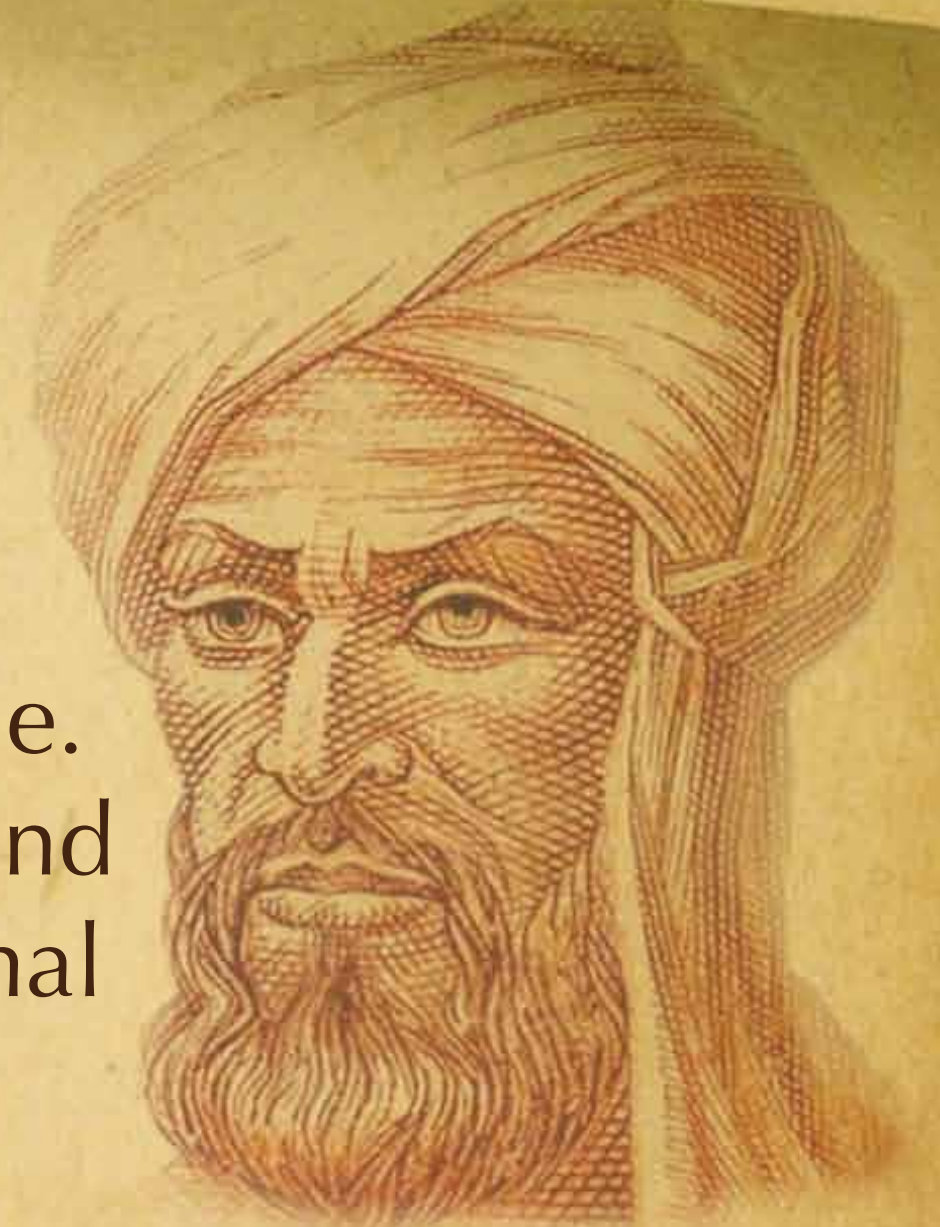

**Mohammad Ibn Musa Al-Khwarizmi** was one of the greatest scientists of his time. He was a mathematician, an astronomer and a geographer. He introduced the decimal positional number system to the world. He made a great contribution to Mathematics when he developed "Algebra" (derived from the word Al-Jabr) and "algorithms" to which he gave his name.

His wrote "*The Compendious Book on Calculation by Completion and Balancing*" which presented the first systematic solution of linear and quadratic equations in Arabic. In 1145 CE, the book was translated into Latin by Robert of Chester (Robertus Castrensis). It was used until the sixteenth century as the principal mathematical text-book of European universities.

In mathematics and computer science, an algorithm is a programming procedure that tells your computer precisely what steps to take to solve a problem or reach a goal. The ingredients are called inputs, while the results are called the outputs. Algorithms can perform calculation, data processing and automated reasoning tasks.



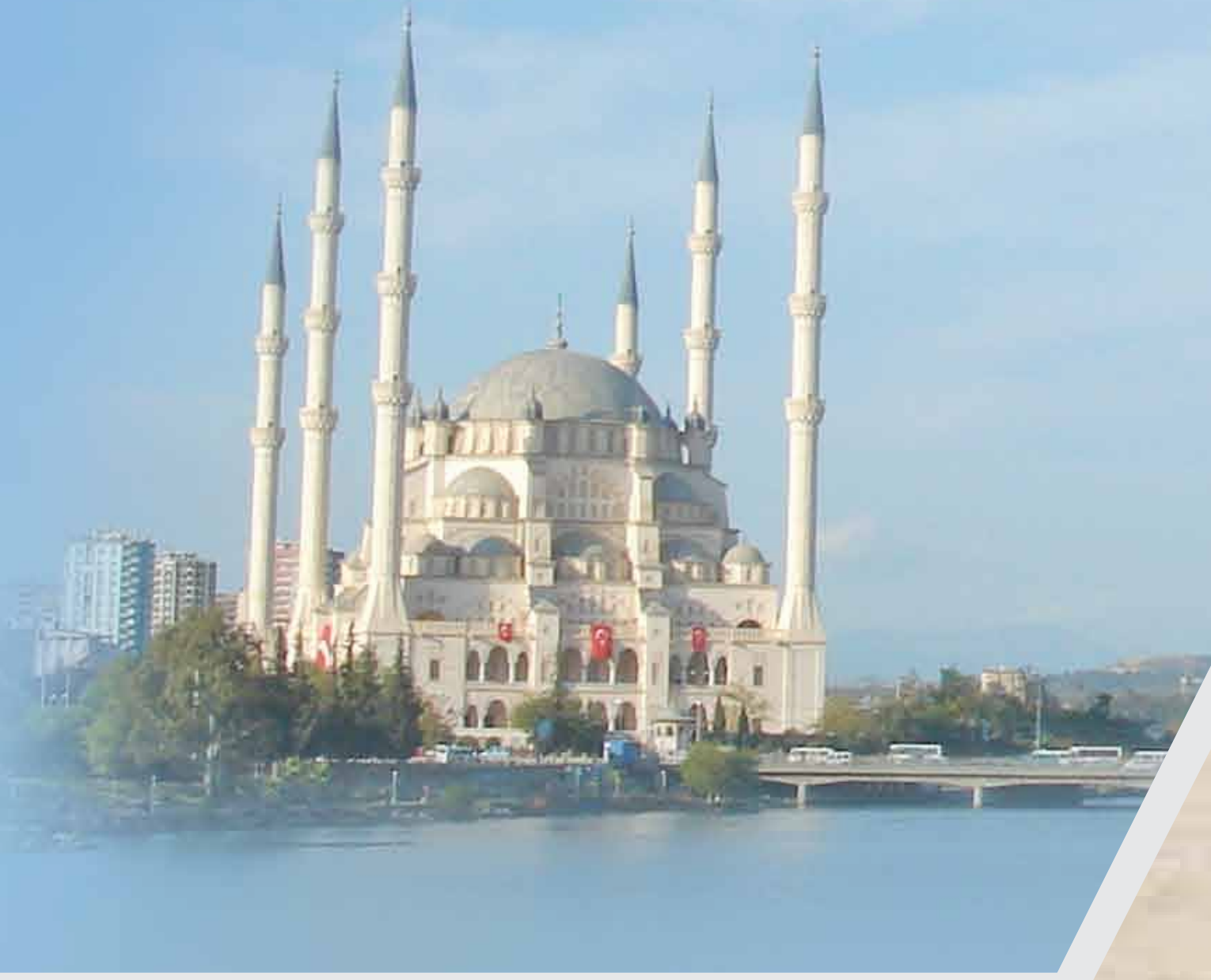

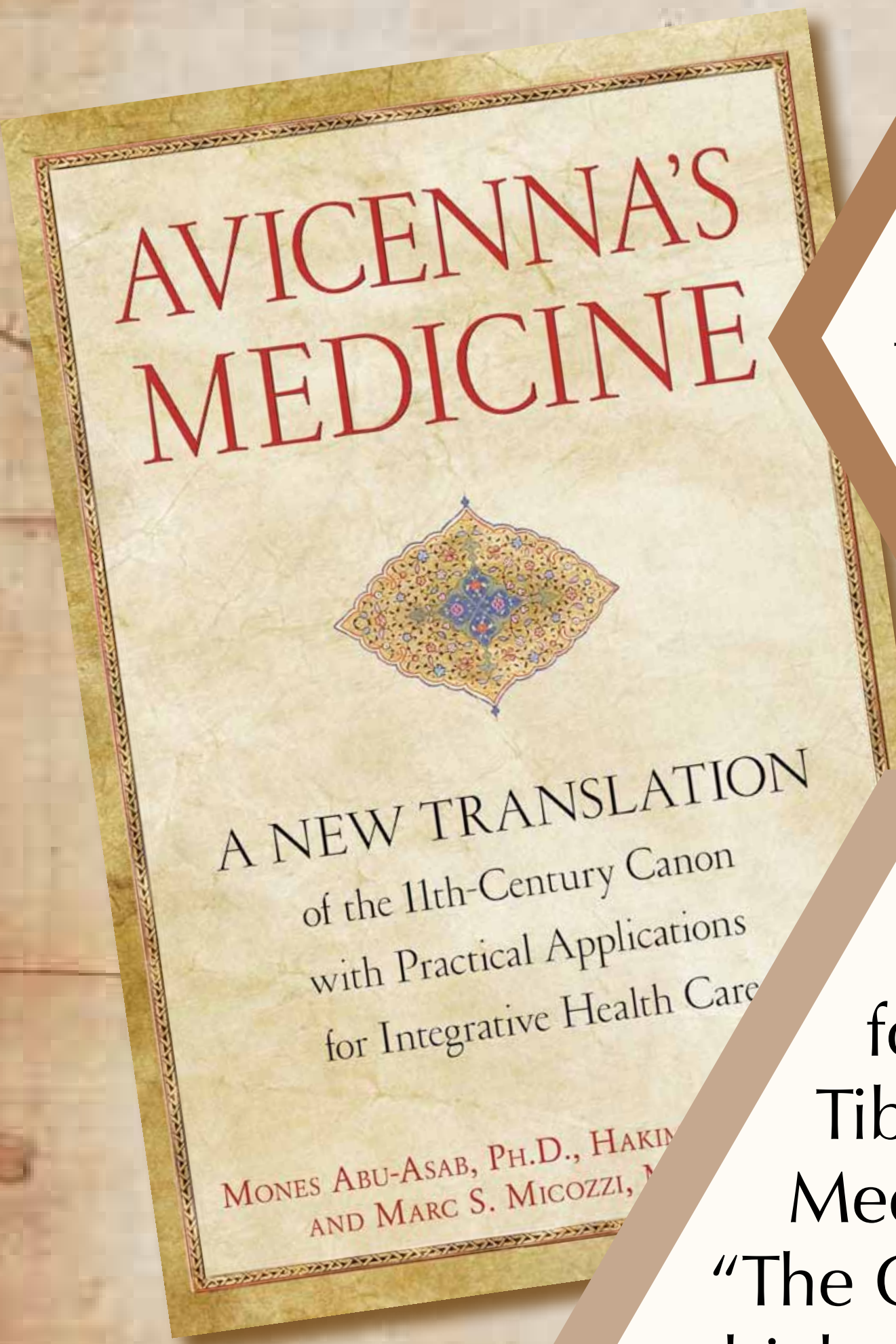
The Father of Modern Medicine

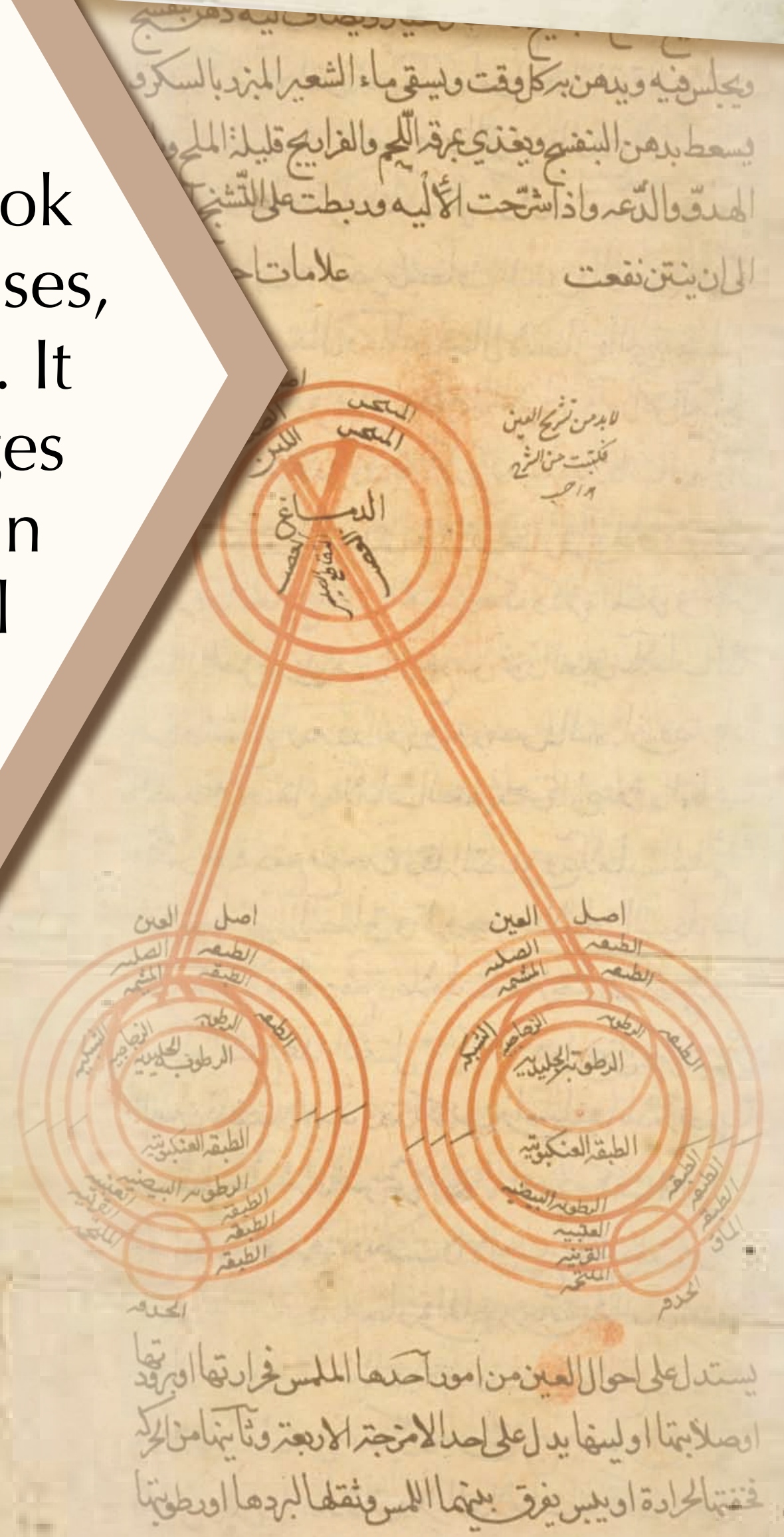
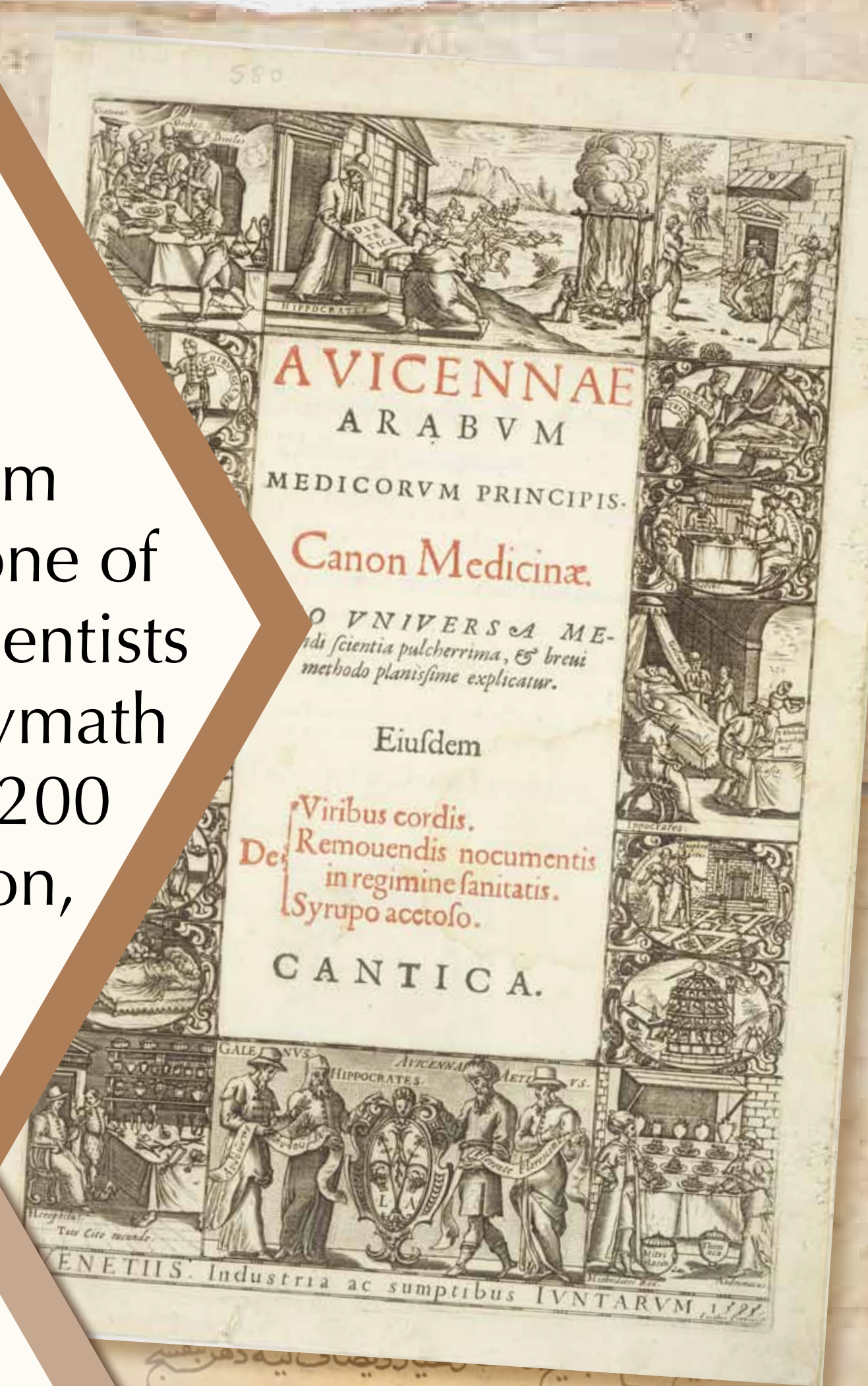

**Ibn Sina** was one of the most eminent Muslim scholars in medicine and one of the most famous Muslim scientists in the world. He was a polymath and the author of almost 200 books on science, religion, and philosophy.



**Avicenna** is famous for his book "Al-Qanun Fi-Tibb" which means the law of Medicine, commonly known as "The Canon". It is a 14-volume book which classifies and describes diseases, and outlines their assumed causes. It was translated to different languages and was a standard medical text in Europe for seven centuries (until early eighteenth century). In 1973, Avicenna's "Canon of Medicine" was reprinted in New York.

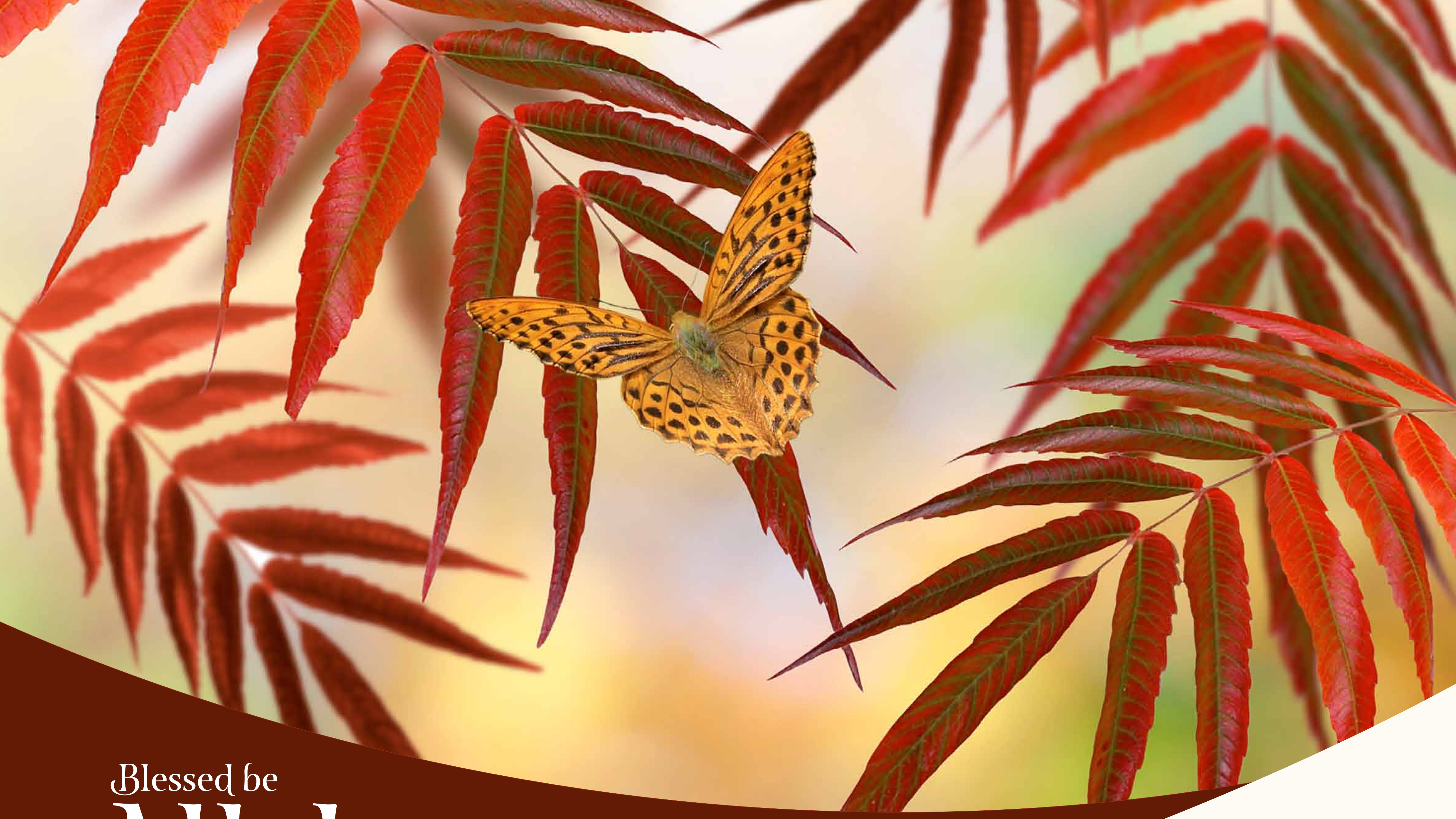
