Yet they are **UNABLE** to lead and communicate **effectively** in English on Islamic subjects primarily **because** they lack the proper terms and concepts to do so.



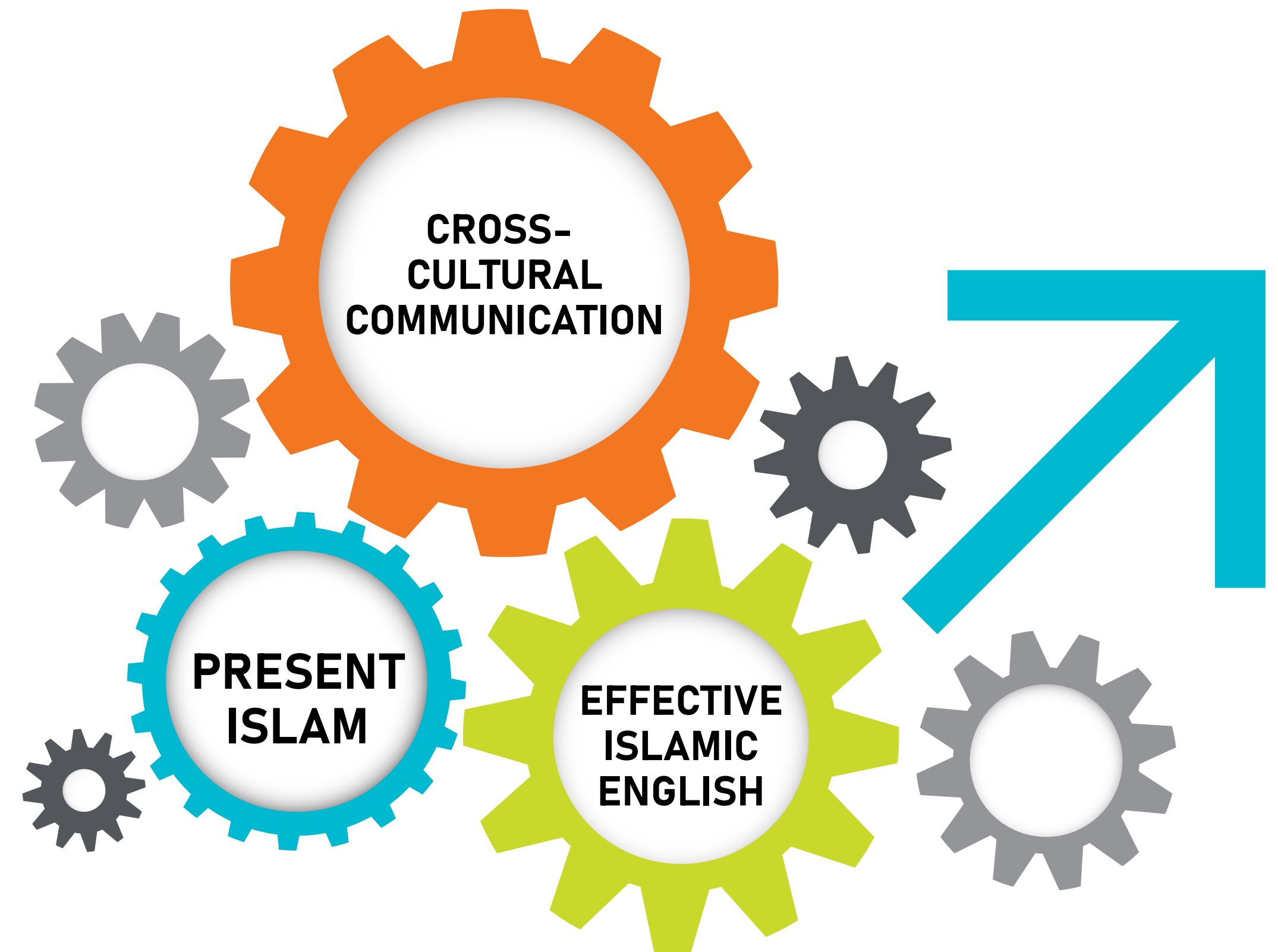

RATIONALE:

The main objective of EIECC program is to:

Assist them to communicate effectively in any cross-cultural communication.



OBJECTIVES:

By the end of the program the participants will have acquired the following:

- An improvement of Islamic English concepts, terms, statements, reasonable knowledge etc.,
- An improvement of communication competency.
- An improvement of self-led teams (communities of commitment).
- The ability to discuss Islamic concepts in English.
- The ability to give short presentations on Islamic topics.
- An awareness of the subtleties & importance of language sensitivity in cross-cultural communication.
- Ignition of the passion to use English and lead in communicating Islam to others.



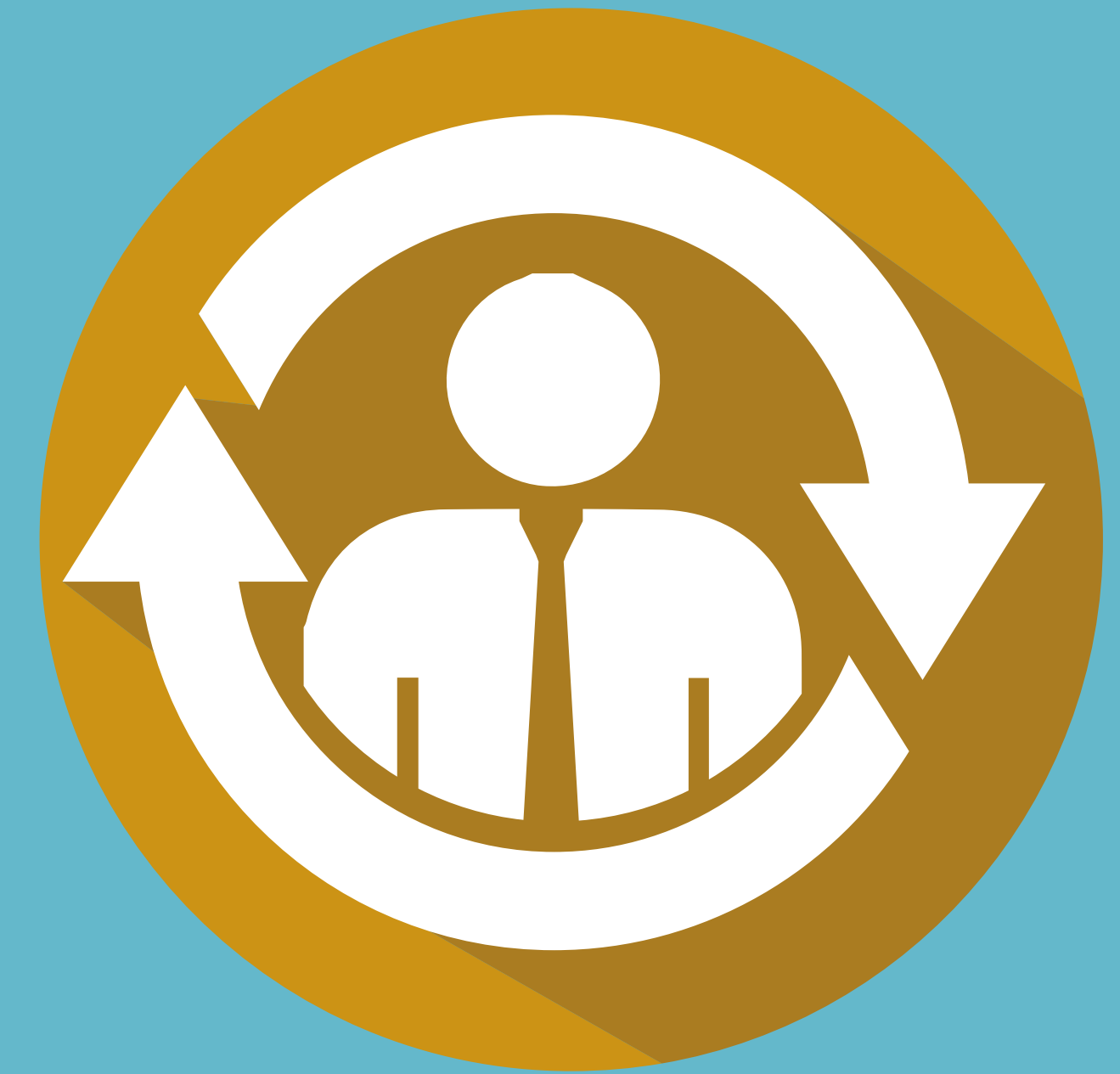
REQUIREMENTS & DURATION:

REQUIREMENTS:

- Willingness to present Islam in its true light.
- Able to take part in a conversation on general topics.
- Possess a basic level of fluency in English.
- Previous experience as a da'ee is not a must.

DURATION:

- The program consists of a total of 40 hours.
 - 20 hours in class.
 - 20 hours working on projects outside the class.
- Workshops may be offered as 1 or 2-day (5 -10 hrs) workshop.
