



**OBJECTIVES:** By the end of the program the participants will have acquired the following:

An improvement of Islamic English concepts, terms, statements, reasonable knowledge etc.,

An improvement of communication competency.

An improvement of self-led teams (communities of commitment).

# REQUIREMENTS & DURATION:

### **REQUIREMENTS:**

- Willingness to present Islam in its true light.
- Able to take part in a conversation on general topics.
- Possess a basic level of fluency in English.
- Previous experience as a da'ee is not a must.

#### **DURATION:**

The program consists of a total of 40 hours. 20 hours in class.

20 hours working on projects outside the class.

Workshops may be offered as1 or 2-day (5 -10 hrs) workshop.





#### **PARTICIPANTS:**


